KIWANIS YOUTH PROGRAMS TASK FORCE ON COMMITTEE STRUCTURE

KEY CLUB INTERNATIONAL POLICY AMENDMENTS

That the Kiwanis Youth Programs Board reviewed the Key Club International policy amendments and recognition program revisions adopted by the Key Club International Board at its meeting held February 2, 2019 and took action as follows:

- Policy Amendments 1-3, 5-6, 8-17, 19-21, 23-27, 32, 35, and 38 as well as changes to all recognition programs except the Nininger Medal were approved.
- Policy Amendments 4, 7, 18, 22, 33-34, and 36-37 as well as changes to the Nininger Medal were not approved.
- Policy Amendments 28-31 and 39 were not considered for approval at this time because Key Club districts requested reconsideration by the Key Club International Board. This is the district's right per Key Club International Policy P.4.

KEY CLUB INTERNATIONAL BOARD REQUESTS

• The Kiwanis Youth Programs Board increases the "Online Marketing" line of the Key Club International Budget by 10 percent.
