2023-24 DISTINGUISHED DISTRICT CRITERIA

Upon recommendation of the Board Committee on Conventions, Conferences, and Recognition Programs, it was moved and adopted:

That the Kiwanis International Board approves the Distinguished District Recognition Criteria for the 2023-24 administrative year as follows:

DISTRICT RECOGNITION CRITERIA

GROWTH (1 of 2 required)

- Net gain in membership over the Kiwanis administrative year, as certified by October 10, 2024 OR
- Achievement of the new club opening goal, as set by agreement of the president and governor (as president-elect and governor-elect). Districts with a club opening goal of zero (0) will not qualify. A district may achieve new club opening credit for a Kiwanis club in another nation under any program approved as such by the Kiwanis International Board.

SERVICE & EDUCATION (3 of 5 required)

• Minimum required increase in overall giving to the Kiwanis Children's Fund over the previous Kiwanis administrative year, from all district sources (as determined by KCF).

OR

• Totally of at least two (2) new Builders Clubs and 1 (one) new K-Kids club chartered within the district over the administrative year.

OR

• Submission of club signature project in the Kiwanis International annual signature project contest.

OR

• Increase in club leadership education (CLE) participation over the previous administrative year.

OR

• Achievement of 90% compliance in required background checks among all required leaders.

PRESIDENT'S BEACON DISTRICT CRITERIA

GROWTH (3 of 3 required)

• Meet the above requirements to become a Distinguished District.

AND

• Achieve a net gain in active Kiwanis clubs over the previous Kiwanis administrative year (as certified by October 10, 2024).

AND

• Charter a total of three (3) additional new Builders Clubs and two (2) additional new K-Kids clubs over the previous Kiwanis administrative year.

DISTRICT GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE

The Kiwanis International Board directs staff to develop templates for both a trustee and a lieutenant governor governance system to be shared with the Kiwanis International Board at the October 2023 board meeting.

That the Kiwanis International Board creates an Asia-Pacific Growth Task Force to be appointed by the President which will report activities and recommendations through the Board Committee on Membership.

ELECTRONIC PAYMENT OPTIONS FOR CLUB DUES

Upon recommendation of the Board Committee on Membership, it was moved and adopted:

That the Kiwanis International Board asks staff to study electronic payment options and resources for clubs to conveniently collect dues on a monthly or quarterly basis and report findings and an education plan for the same back to the Board Committee on Membership at the October 2023 Board Meeting.

RATIFICATION OF BYLAW AMENDMENTS TO THE KIWANIS CHILDREN'S FUND BYLAWS

Upon motion duly made by Trustee Gary Graham, it was moved and adopted:

That the Kiwanis International Board ratifies the amendments made by the Kiwanis Children's Fund Board at its meeting on March 29, 2023, to restructure its board and board committees. The Kiwanis International Board urges the Kiwanis Children's Fund Board to reconsider the matter of having an at-large seat on its Board.

Upon motion duly made by Trustee Hope Markes, it was moved and adopted:

That the Kiwanis International Board directs the Kiwanis Children's Fund Board to further amend its bylaws to change the office of President, President-elect, Vice President, and Immediate Past President to be titled Chair, Chair-elect, Vice Chair, and Immediate Past Chair respectively, to comply with the Kiwanis International Bylaws regarding subsidiaries.
