OTHER BUSINESS

OPTIONAL AT-LARGE TRUSTEE SEAT

At its meeting on April 22, 2023, the Kiwanis International Board urged the Kiwanis Children's Fund Board to reconsider the matter of having the optional at-large seat on the Children's Fund Board. The Children's Fund Board considered the matter at this meeting with a great deal of discussion.

The following motion duly made by Trustee Rick Poulton, and seconded, failed.

That the Kiwanis Children's Fund Board agrees with the recommendation of the Kiwanis International Board to eliminate the optional at-large seat from the Children's Fund Board. (Motion FAILED)

CHILDREN'S FUND OFFICER TITLES

At its meeting on April 22, 2023, the Kiwanis International Board directed the Kiwanis Children's Fund to reconsider to further amend the Children's Fund bylaws to change the title of its officers from "President" to "Chair" to comply with the Kiwanis International Bylaws regarding subsidiaries. The Children's Fund Board considered the matter at this meeting with a great deal of discussion. The Board particularly noted, due to the important work of the organization, the mission of both entities, and the upcoming Possibility Project, the Children's Fund is willing to explore the matter further.

That the Kiwanis Children's Fund Board refers the matter of the title of Children's Fund officers to the Joint Committee of Kiwanis International and the Kiwanis Children's Fund for consideration and a recommendation to be made to both boards.
