AMENDMENT 1: LANGUAGE CLEANUP AND DISTRICT SUBMISSION OF RESOLUTIONS

To clarify current language of the Kiwanis International Bylaws requiring districts to be in good standing to submit resolutions

AMENDMENT 2: REGIONAL BOARDS TO PROPOSE RESOLUTIONS AND AMENDMENTS Purpose: To allow regional board to propose resolutions and amendments to be considered at the International Conventions.

AMENDMENT 3: REMOTE VOTING FOR KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS Purpose: To provide for candidate nominations and initial review of proposed amendments and resolutions at the Kiwanis International Convention, with final voting to take place via secure remote voting.
